Joel Rosenberg, conductor



Joel Rosenberg is the Music Director of the American West Symphony, Paradigm Chamber Orchestra, and Utah's Amazing Earthfest. He is a recipient of the 2023 Governor's Mansion Award in the Arts. The Salt Lake Tribune chose his conducting of Bizet's *Carmen* as one of the "Ten Best Performances of the Year." He has performed, and recorded for Albany Records, the William Wallace Concertino for Viola with the Slovak Radio Orchestra in a concert sponsored by the US Embassy in Bratislava. Two recent recordings are, "Music for Viola and Piano" with pianist Jed Moss includes sonatas of Schubert, Bach and Bloch and, "Joel Rosenberg plays Bach," music from the unaccompanied cello suites and

sonatas and partitas for solo violin.


Joel is a graduate of Juilliard in New York City, and a recipient of a Fulbright Grant to Rome, Italy. While in Italy he received a Diploma of Merit, from the Accademia Musicale Chigiana in Siena. He is also a recipient of an Individual Artist Award from the State of Utah.

He recently performed three concerts in Vienna and conducted the Elbland Philharmonic in Riesa, Meissen and Pirna Germany in music of Beethoven, Copland, Dvorak and Kelly Richardson. While in Germany he performed in a chamber music concert with the principal players of the Elbland Philharmonic.

The New Zealand Herald reviewing his performance of "Madam Butterfly" wrote, "Much of the success of this production lies at the hands of Joel Rosenberg who as music director had the Auckland Philharmonia in the right form to carry the whole along at the right pace and sensitivity." The Portland Oregonian reviewing his conducting of the "Nutcracker" with Ballet West said, "Mr. Rosenberg proved to be an expert ballet conductor."

Joel Rosenberg has conducted the Elizabethan Philharmonic and Orchestra of Victoria with the Australian Ballet at the Sydney Opera House, in Melbourne and Canberra, The Orchestra of the Conservatory Santa Cecilia in Rome, Italy, New Mexico Symphony, Grand Teton Music Festival, The Utah Oratorio Society, Auckland Philharmonia, Erik Hawkins Dance Company, San Francisco Ballet, National Orchestra of South Africa with PACT Ballet in Pretoria and Johannesburg, Utah, Phoenix and Portland Symphonies with Ballet West, a tour of Japan for Sony with soloists from the Royal Opera House at Covent Garden and performances with Pianist Leon Fleisher.

He has performed as principal viola under Pierre Boulez and has been a guest violist with the DaVinci String Quartet, the Brigham Young University String Quartet and Piano Quartet, the University of Utah Woodwind Quintet and the Salt Lake Chamber Music Society. The Oregon Symphony invited him to join them for a recording and performances of music of Eric Korngold.



Competition; Third prize of UMTA State Piano Concerto Competition; honorable mention in 2017 YAMAHA national piano competition and KAWAI Asia Piano Competition, Junior Professional. As a collaborative pianist and chamber musician, she was invited to the Saarburg Chamber Music Festival in 2017 and has been a piano accompanist with the Salt Lake Chinese Choir since 2018, University of Utah Chamber Choir and A Capella Choir since 2022.



Natalie Sun is a 2nd grader, and she started piano at age 4. Natalie has been a First Prize winner at numerous piano competitions, including 2023 Salt Lake piano competition age 7-10 romantic, 2023 Ogden Piano Festival Concerto Competition and solo competition Elementary group, Concerto competition (age 7-14) at the 2023 Helen Taylor Johannesen International Piano Festival, young elementary concerto competition at the 2023 Summer Arts piano competition at the University of Utah. Natalie has performed with American West Symphony and Chamber

Orchestra in 2023. Natalie loves animals, and she wants to be a veterinarian and a concert pianist in the future.



Annie Jia (10) is a student pianist under the guidance of Professor Jie Lu. In 2023, Annie achieved notable success by winning second place in the Elementary Division at the UMTA Piano Concerto Competition, second place in the Young Elementary Concerto Division of the University of Utah SummerArts Piano Competition, first place in the Concerto Division of the Salt Lake Piano Competition and first prize in the Elementary Division at the American Mountain West International piano competition. She also

won second place in the Young Elementary Solo Division of the 2022 University of Utah SummerArts Piano Competition. Annie is also an artist, swimmer, climber and nature enthusiast. Together with her sister Kourtney, Annie likes to visit a senior center to share the gift of music, bringing happiness and love to those in the community.


